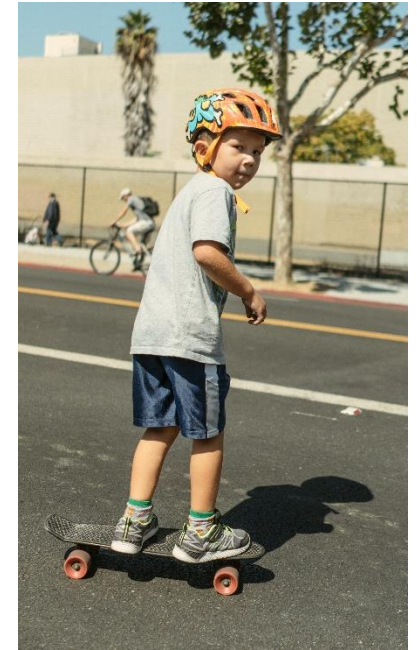




A Story Guide

comfortable.

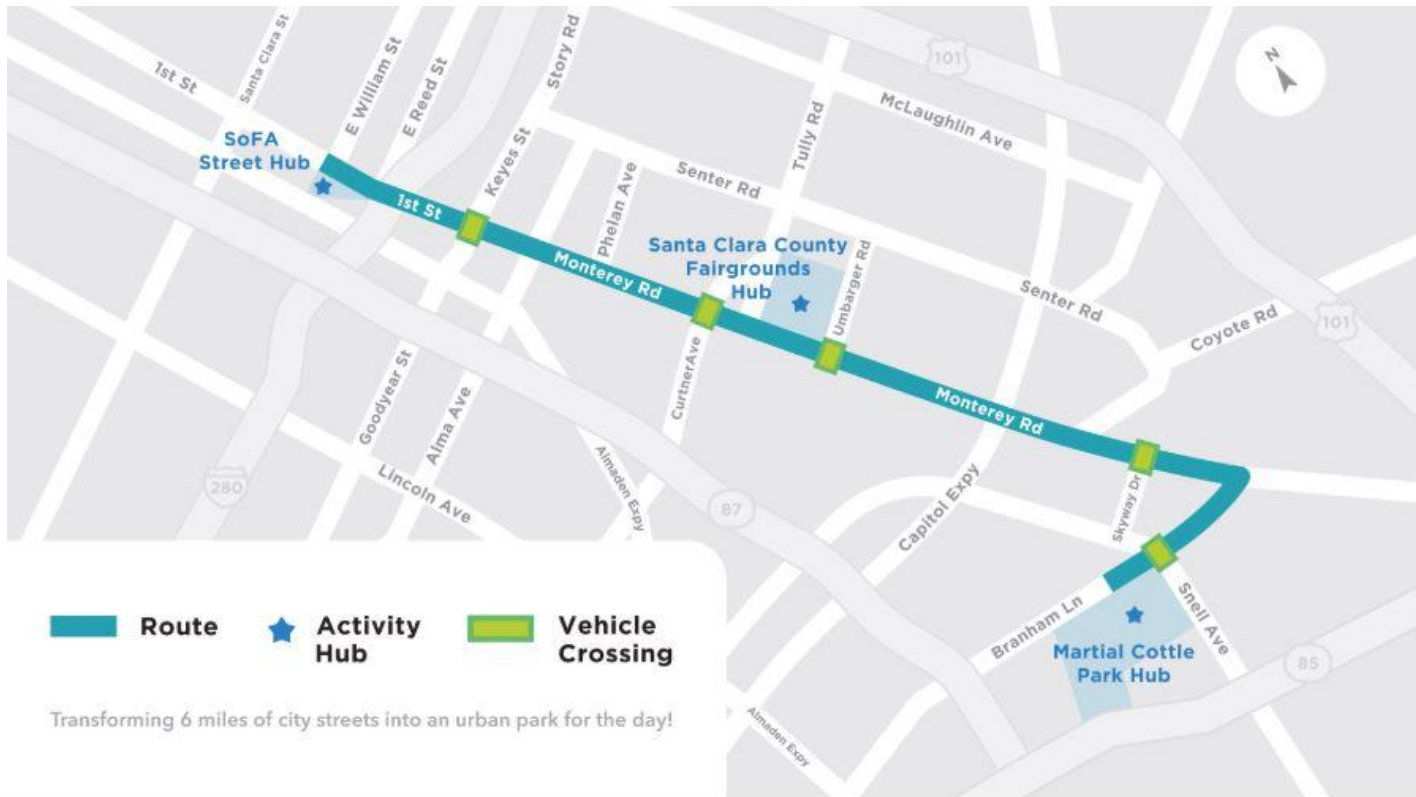


If I need a
